



Call for papers for a special series of articles on artificial intelligence

June 2026

The journal *Economie et Statistique / Economics and Statistics* will devote a series of articles to artificial intelligence.

There are no restrictions on topics. Examples of areas likely to be disrupted by artificial intelligence include:

- job content and wage distribution;
- working conditions and labour relations;
- environment, energy consumption;
- social interactions and everyday life;
- scientific activity and its organisation;
- the collection and use of big data;
- teaching activities and learning conditions.

This list is not exhaustive. For each topic, the journal welcomes original contributions as well as reviews of the academic literature.

Submissions are expected **until the 30th of November 2026**. Interested authors are invited to send their manuscripts to the journal's editorial office: redaction-ecostat@insee.fr. These will be subject to the journal's usual review process. Accepted papers may be published online in advance of their inclusion in an issue, as part of thematic sections.
