

Call for papers for a special series of articles on employment and labour

October 2024

The journal *Economie et Statistique / Economics and Statistics* will devote a series of articles to labour and employment.

There are no restrictions on topics. Examples of possible topics include:

- Working conditions and working hours: organisation, teleworking, well-being at work, management, etc.;

- Evaluation of public policies on employment, unemployment and unemployment insurance, labour costs, etc.;

- Unemployment and the unemployment halo: determinants, persistence, exit, etc.
- Climate transition and employment;
- Demography, ageing, immigration and the labour market;
- Renewal of occupations, attractiveness of occupations, job quality, etc.;
- Returns to education and to lifelong learning;
- Integration into the labour market, careers;
- Innovation and employment, diffusion of AI in companies, links with growth and productivity.

This list is not exhaustive. For each topic, the journal welcomes original contributions as well as reviews of the academic literature.

Submissions are expected **until the 31st of March 2025**. Interested authors are invited to send their manuscripts to the journal's editorial office: <u>redaction-ecostat@insee.fr</u>. These will be subject to the journal's usual review process. Accepted papers may be published online in advance of their inclusion in an issue, as part of thematic sections.
