Producer and Import Price Indices in industry - December 2009

In December, the industrial prices went on increasing slightly

Producer price indices in industry

FRENCH MARKET: +0,2 %

In December, the producer price indices on the French market went on increasing (+0,2 %), on the same pace than in November.

The prices of refined petroleum products still increased, but moderately

In a context of slight decrease of crude petroleum prices, the prices of refined petroleum products progressed only of +0,8 %, vs. +3,3 % and +3,2 % respectively in November and October. The persistence of a noticeable rise of kerosene prices in December explains this progression.

The prices of transport equipment and beverages were increasing

After three months of almost stability, transport equipment prices progressed markedly (+0.8 %), because of the sales of "models 2010" motorcars. The food products prices increased slightly, thanks to the increase of beverages prices (+1,1 %).

FOREIGN MARKETS: +0,0 %

The stability of the French producer price indices on the external markets results from a moderate increase of food products prices (+0,7 %) and a noticeable decrease of refined petroleum products (-2,1 %). The difference between this latter change and the domestic market (+0.8 %) comes from a different structure of the sales between the two kinds of markets. The increase of food products prices was in line with tensions on food materials prices, especially cocoa prices.


ALL MARKETS: +0,1 %

On all markets, the progression was of +0,1 % on one month. On a year, the decrease lessened (-2,4 % after -4,0 % in November): the prices of refined petroleum products recorded then an increase of +21,9 % while food products prices exposed a notable withdraw (-8,6 %) due for -5,3 % to an accounting artefact "LME" (cf. addition to IR July 2009 n°206).

Import prices indices of industrial products: +0,1 %

The import prices of industrial products were almost stable in December (+0,1 %), after a progression of +0,7 % in November. The increase of food products prices (+0,2 %) was moderated by the noticeable decrease of dairy products and flours. On a year, the withdraw of the whole industrial products prices reached -0.6 %.





(1) Reading note: the evolution of the index between Oct.09 and Nov.09 published last month was equal to 0,4 %. It is updated to 0,3 %; that is to a say a revision of -0,1 %.

To know more about French PPI:

- Industrial producer price indices for the French market are measured at basic prices (excluding VAT and tax on revenues, and before deduction of any subsidies on the products), in accordance with European Regulation n°1165/98. However, purchaser price series (including non deductible taxes minus subsidies on the products, called also "ex-work prices") are also available, notably for the purposes of index-linking for contracts, on http://indicespro.insee.fr. This site provides also link factors between former and new series.
- French industrial producer price indices for foreign markets are converted into Euros, therefore include exchange rate effects, and are closed to free on board (FOB) prices. All exports are taken into consideration, whether they are intra-group or not.
- By combining these two indices, we get industrial producer price indices for all markets (French and foreign markets).
- Import prices of industrial products are converted into Euros, therefore include exchange effects, and are closed to cost insurance and freight (CIF) prices. All imports are taken into consideration, whether they are intra-group or not.
