Turnover in industry and construction – February 2011

In February 2011, the turnover in manufacturing industry rose by 1.1%

Every indices in this issue are in value, seasonally and working-day adjusted.


In February 2011, the turnover increased by 1.1% in the *manufacturing industry*, after +2,7% in January. *Exports* rose (+1.4%, after +6,6 in January).

The turnover went up in the *manufacture of transport* equipment (+2.2%) in February, either in the *manufacture of other transport equipment* (+3.9%) and in the *manufacture of motor vehicles* (+1.3%).

In February, the turnover increased in the manufacture of food products and beverages (+1.4%), in the other manufacturing (+0.4%), in the electrical and electronic equipment; machine equipment (+1.4%) and in the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (+1.5%).

The turnover of the *industry as a whole* (B to E) also rose in February (+0.8%).

Quarter-on-quarter (Q/Q-1), the turnover in the *manufacturing industry* grew by 4.5%. It was mostly up in the *other manufacturing* (+4.1%) and in the *manufacture of transport equipment* (+6.3%).

Year-on-year (Q/Q-4), the turnover in *manufacturing industry* rose by 10.7%. It particularly grew in the *other manufacturing* (+10.5%).
