■ Turnover in industry and construction – May 2011

The turnover in manufacturing industry significantly rose in may 2011 (+2.1%)

Every indices in this issue are in value, seasonally and working-day adjusted.

In May 2011, the turnover increased (+2.1%) in the *manufacturing industry*, after a slight growth (+0.4%) in April. *Exports* went up (+3.3%, after –1.1% in April).

In May 2011, the turnover clearly grew in the *manufacture of transport equipment* (+4.7%), particularly in the *manufacture of other transport equipment* (+5.8%).

The turnover also increased in the *other manufacturing* (+1.7%), in the *electrical and electronic equipment ; machine equipment* (+3.1%) and in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+0.5%).

It was stable in the *manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (+0.0%).

The turnover of the *industry as a whole* (B to E) was up in May (+2.1%).

In the last three months (Q/Q–1), the turnover in the *manufacturing industry* grew by 2.2%. It particularly increased in the *other manufacturing* (+2.4%) and in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+2.4%).

Year-on-year (Q/Q–4), the turnover in *manufacturing industry* rose by 10.1%. It was particularly up in the *other manufacturing* (+9.9%).
