Monthly business survey in the building industry – June 2014

The economic climate gets worse in the building industry in June 2014

According to the business managers surveyed in June 2014, the situation gets worse in the building industry. The composite indicator has slumped by four points and has reached its lowest level since mid-2009. It stays below its long-term average. The turning-point indicator has gone into the unfavorable zone.

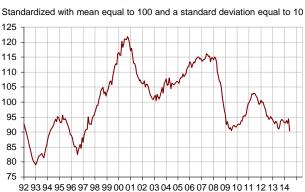
Activity remains deteriorated

Business managers consider that their activity is deteriorated in the recent period. They stay pessimistic about their activity for the next few months. The corresponding balances of opinion are significantly below their long-term average.

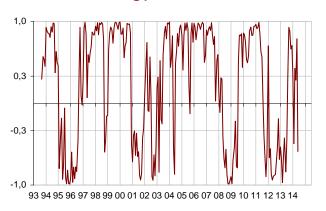
Decreasing employment

Much more business managers than in May indicate job losses. The corresponding balances of opinion to past and expected employment are substantially below their long-term average.

Order books are still considered lower than normal

In June, more business managers than in May consider their order books lower than normal. The corresponding balance of opinion is substantially below its long-term average.

Productive capacity underused again

The productive capacity utilization rate is almost stable and stays below its long-term average. At the same time, almost one business manager out of four declares having difficulties increasing his activity.

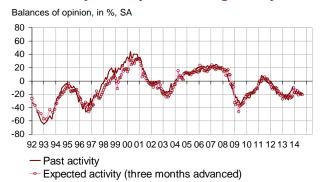
Prices not very dynamic

In June, slightly less business managers than in May indicate price downturns. But the corresponding balance of opinion is still well below its long-term average.
