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## ■ Turnover in industry and construction – April 2013

### In April 2013, the turnover in manufacturing industry increased by 0.3% compared to March

Every index in this issue is in value, seasonally and working-day adjusted.

In March 2013, the turnover rose slightly in the **manufacturing industry** (+0.3%), due to a high growth in exports (+3.1%).

The turnover increased significantly in the *manufacturing industry* without the *manufacture of transport equipment* (+1.2%).

#### The turnover grew over the last three months...

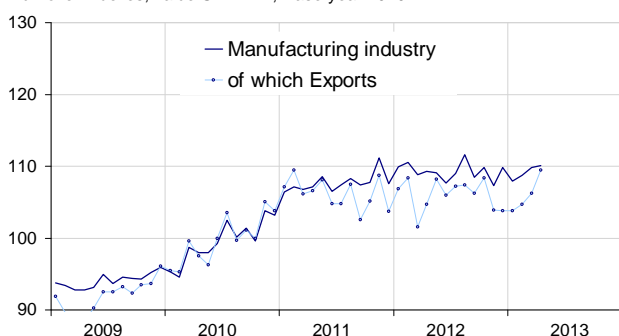
Over the quarter (q-o-q), the turnover rose substantially in the *manufacturing industry* (+1.1%). It increased sharply in the *manufacture of transport equipments* (+5.9%). It grew moderately in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+0.8%) and in the *electrical and electronic equipment; machine equipment* (+1.0%).

#### ... and remained stable over the last year

Year-on-year, the turnover leveled off in the *manufacturing industry* (0.0%). It rose sharply in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+3.5%) and in the *manufacture of transport equipment* (+2.3%). On the other hand, it decreased significantly in *other industries* (-1.4%) and in the *manufacture of food and refined petroleum products* (-5.8%).

#### Monthly variations

In April 2013, the turnover increased in other industries (+1.2%), mainly in the *manufacture of basic metals and fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment* (+2.0%). It grew in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+1.5%) and in the *electrical and electronic equipment; machine equipment* (+1.3%). It remained stable in the *manufacture of coke and refined petroleum* (+0.1%). On the contrary, it fell considerably in the *manufacture of transport equipment* (-3.9%) after a high rise in March (+10.2%), due to a steeply decline in the *manufacture of other transport equipment* (-11.5%).
