■ Quarterly business survey in the building crafts sector - April 2014

The economic climate stays deteriorated in the building crafts sector, in April 2014

According to the business managers surveyed in April 2014, economic outlook climate stays deteriorated in the building crafts sector.

Activity stays sluggish

In April 2014, more craftsmen than in January indicate a decrease in their past activity. Conversely, fewer craftsmen indicate a fall in their expected activity. The corresponding balances of opinion stay significantly below their long-term average.

The general business outlook, which expresses the craftsmen's opinion on the overall change in the sector, is stable and the corresponding balance of opinion remains below its long-term average.

Fewer craftsmen indicate job losses


Fewer craftsmen than in January indicate job losses in the recent period and for the next few months. The corresponding balances of opinion remain below their long-term average.

Recruiting problems are stable

Recruiting problems concerned around one firm out of three. This proportion remains inferior to its long-term average. The rate of businesses training apprentices is almost stable at 39 %.
