Monthly business survey in the building industry – April 2014

The economic climate is still unfavorable in the building industry in April 2014

According to the business managers surveyed in April 2014, the situation gets worse again in the building industry. The composite indicator has decreased by one point and stays below its long-term average. The turning-point indicator is in the neutral zone.

Activity remains deteriorated

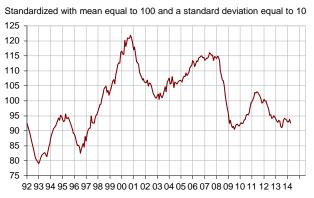
Business managers consider that their activity is still deteriorated in the recent period. Slightly more business managers than in March forecast a fall of their activity for the next few months.

The general business outlook, which expresses the business manager's opinions about the general trend in the sector, is worse then the last quarter and remains sharply below its long-term average.

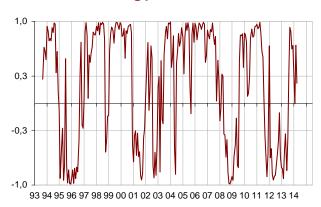
Decreasing employment

More business managers than in March indicate job losses. The balances of opinion corresponding to past employment and expected employment stay substantially below their long-term average.

Order books are still considered lower than normal

In April, business managers still consider their order books lower than normal.

Productive capacity underused again

The productive capacity utilization rate has stabilized and stays below its long-term average. At the same time, almost one business manager out of four declares having difficulties increasing his activity.

42 % of building firm still have difficulties in recruiting labor force; this ratio is under its long-term average.

Prices not very dynamic

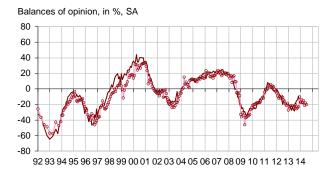
In April, more business managers than in March indicate price downturns. The corresponding balance of opinion is still well below its long-term average.

According to business leaders, the cash-flow position of the overall sector is more deteriorated than in the previous quarter and the repayment period is stable.

Productive capacity utilization rate



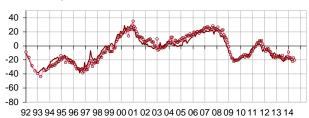
Activity tendency in the building industry

- -- Expected activity (three months advanced)

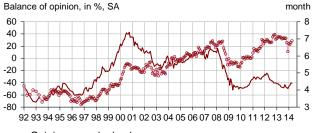
Workforce size tendency in the building industry
