Producer and Import Price Indices in industry – March 2014

In March, prices dipped on all markets

• Producer price indices in French industry

FRENCH MARKET: -0.4 % in March

In March, French producer prices in industry for French market dipped (-0.4 % after -0.1 %). Energy prices moved down significantly, while prices for other products fell more moderately. Food prices were the only exception (+0.2 %).

Energy prices fell anew

Prices for refined petroleum products dropped again in March (-1.9 % and -0.2 %), driven by the price for Brent crude sourced from the North Sea, which declined in euro terms (-2.0 %), more strongly than in dollar terms (-0.7 %) due to the appreciation of the euro against the dollar.

Electricity (-1.2 %) and gas (-3.1 %) prices also moved down.

Prices for most "other manufactured products" slipped

Except for prices for repair and maintenance services of machinery (+0.3 %), prices for "other manufactured products" dipped: the fall in prices for raw materials (oil, zinc, scrap metals...) indeed affected prices for basic metals (-0.3 %) and for chemical products (-0.3 %), most notably other basic organic chemical products (-0.7 %).

Food prices increased moderately....

Food prices advanced in March ($\pm 0.2\%$ after 0.0 % in February) due to the significant rise in prices for mineral waters and soft drinks ($\pm 2.7\%$) upon the annual renegotiation of prices, and to the notable increase in prices for both dairy products ($\pm 1.1\%$) and grape wines ($\pm 1.0\%$). Conversely, prices for poultry meat and oils moved down ($\pm 0.6\%$ in both cases).

FOREIGN MARKETS: -0.2% in March

Producer prices of French industrial products sold on foreign markets dropped slightly (-0.2 % after 0.0 % in February). The fall in prices for refined petroleum products (-1.3 %) indeed combined with the decline in prices for basic metals (-1.0 %), computer products (-0.4 %) and pharmaceutical products (-0.6 %).


ALL MARKETS: -0.4 % in March

On all markets, prices dipped in March (-0.4 % after 0.0 % in February). Year over year, the decline in prices for refined petroleum products (-8.4 %) was still marked, and now significant for computer and electrical products (-1.7 %) and for "other manufactured products" (-1.5 %).

• Import price indices of industrial products: -0.6 % in March

Import prices fell in March (-0.6 % after -0.1 % in February). As on foreign markets, the buying prices for refined petroleum products and crude oil declined, as well as prices for computer products (-0.5 %), pharmaceutical products (-0.8 %) and basic metals (-0.6 %) in a context of lower raw material prices and stronger competition.



Producer price indices of manufactured products sold on the french market



(1) Reading note: the evolution of the index between January and February 2014 published at the end of March was equal to -0.1 %. It is updated to 0 %; that is to say a revision of +0,1 %.

For more information about French PPI:

Producer and import price indices of industrial products are regulated by the European Regulation n°1165/98 on short-term statistics. They are annually chain-linked Laspeyres indices, with reference year 2010.

The French producer prices of industrial products sold on the French market presented here are "basic prices" in the sense of the national accounts, measuring the income of the producer (excluding VAT and taxes on products. and before deduction of any subsidies on the products). However, market price series (including non deductible taxes on the products, subsidies deducted) are also available, notably for the purpose of contract escalation, on BDM website: http://www.bdm.insee.fr/.

Import prices of industrial products are measured as much as possible according to the "CIF" concept (cost of insurance and freight included). *i.e.* valued at the French border. They are converted into Euros and therefore include exchange effects. All imports are taken into consideration, whether they are intra-group or not.
