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■ Turnover in industry and construction – December 2012

In December 2012, the turnover in manufacturing industry grew by 2.2% compared to November

Warning : from January 2013, the index of turnover will be base 2010 and referenced to 2010.

Every index in this issue is in value, seasonally and working-day adjusted.

In December 2012, the turnover increased significantly in the **manufacturing industry** (+2.2%), after a fall in November. Exports rebounded (+2.7%).

In December 2012, the turnover of **industry as a whole** went up by 2.1%.

Decrease over the last three months...

Over the quarter (q-o-q), the turnover decreased moderately in the *manufacturing industry* (–0.8%). It fell in the *manufacture of transport equipment* (–3.1%), in *other manufacturing* (–1.0%) in the *manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (–2.3%) and in the *electrical and electronic equipment; machine equipment* (–1.1%).

...and over the last year

Year-on-year, the turnover decreased in the *manufacturing industry* (–0.9%). It plummeted in the *manufacture of transport equipment* (–5.9%). On the other hand, it soared in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+4.1%).

Monthly variations

In December 2012, the turnover rose sharply in *other manufacturing* (+3.0%), mainly in the *manufacture of chemicals and chemical products* (+5.1%) and in the *manufacture of basic metals and fabricated metal products* (+3.3%). The turnover in *manufacture of transport equipment* rebounded (+4.1%) after a three-month-fall. It went up in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+2.4%) and in the *electrical and electronic equipment; machine equipment* (+0.5%).

On the other hand, the turnover fell considerably in the *manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (–4.1%).
