■ Turnover in industry and construction – October 2011

In October 2011, the turnover in manufacturing industry rose by +1.2%

Every indices in this issue are in value, seasonally and working-day adjusted.

In October 2011, the turnover increased (+1.2%) in the *manufacturing industry*. It declined in September (–1.9%). *Exports* grew by +2.3%, after a fall (–3.1%) in September.

In October 2011, the turnover particularly rose in the *manufacture of transport equipment* (+4.0%), especially in the *manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers* (+5.3%), and in the *manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (+3.4%).

The turnover also increased in the *other manufacturing* (+0.4%) and in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+0.8%).

The turnover was roughly stable in the *electrical and electronic equipment ; machine equipment* (–0.1%) in October 2011.

The turnover of the *industry as a whole* (B to E) went up in October 2011 (+0.9%).

In the last quarter (Q/Q–1), the turnover in the *manufacturing industry* increased (+0.4%). It was noticeably up in the *manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products* (+4.3%) and in the *manufacture of food products and beverages* (+1.5%).

Year-on-year (Q/Q–4), the turnover in *manufacturing industry* rose by 7.4%.
