In the second quarter of 2015, the Housing Rent Reference Index increased by 0.08% over a year

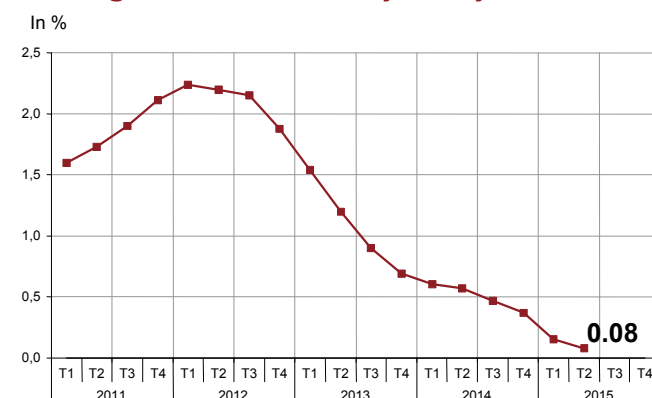

Methodology

The Law of February 8th, 2008 n° 2008-111 on purchasing power modified the Housing Rent Reference Index created by the Law of July 26th, 2005 n° 2005-841. The new index corresponds to an average on the last twelve months of the consumer price index without tobacco and rent.

This index is referenced 100 on the 4th quarter, 1998.

The calculation is done using the non-rounded up values of the consumer price index without tobacco and rent.

The housing rent reference index and the annual variation of the housing rent reference index are rounded up to two decimals.
