Enterprise creation - October 2015

Business start-ups were stable in October 2015

In October 2015, the number of business births was stable after a sharp rebound in September (for all entreprises, seasonally and working-day adjusted). Excluding self managed micro-entrepreneurs, business start-ups decreased slightly (-0.5%). This drop was offset by the growth of self-managed micro-entrepreneurs' registrations (+0.7%).

-4.1% year-on-year (quarterly basis)

The raw amount of births added up in the last three months came down by 4.1% compared to the same months one year before, for all entreprises, mainly because of the self-managed micro-entrepreneurs (-21.7%). Trade and construction were the sectors that most contributed to this decline¹. On the opposite, clearly more start-ups were created in the sectors of transportation and real estate activities compared to the same period last year.

-3.7% year-on-year (twelve months basis)

The raw number of business start-ups totted up during the last twelve months decreased by 3.7% year-on-year, due to the decline in self-managed micro-entrepreneurs' setups (-17.2%). However, for other types of enterprises start-ups increased (+22.1% for sole proprietorships excluding self-managed micro-enterprises and +3.4% for companies).

A little less than one out of two business set-ups is a self-managed micro-entrepreneur's registration

In October 2015, 44.2% of business set-ups over the last twelve months were micro-entrepreneurs' registrations.



Source and definitions

The business start-ups data are build from Sirene register information. The definition of creation adopted by INSEE is based on the concept defined by EUROSTAT, to harmonize and compare European data.

The appearance of a legal operating unit with no predecessor is considered to be a newly created enterprise by Eurostat. This concept of creation relies on new production resources. The business start-up statistics include applications for start-ups as micro-entrepreneurs, starting from the data relating to January 2009.

Raw data and sa-wda

The raw data are observed data. Raw data for a given month may undergo slight modifications during the processing of the following month(s) but become final on the third issue. To allow monthly comparisons, the number of business start-ups is seasonally (sa) and working-day adjusted (wda) with the X12 procedure from SAS software.

N.B.: The series of business start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs and micro-entrepreneurs are adjusted independently of each other, for each sector activity. However, for the self-managed micro-entrepreneurs in the sectors "Financial and insurance activities", "Real estate activities" or "Transportation and storage" raw raw data are similar to seasonally adjusted data, due to a low number of registrations and difficulty identifying a seasonal trend. The serie sa-wda "total" is the total of the series sa-wda by activity sectors on A10.
