Monthly business survey in the building industry – August 2014

The economic climate remains deteriorated in the building industry in August 2014

Warning: seasonal coefficients and parameters of composite indicator were updated for this survey.

According to the business managers surveyed in August 2014, the situation remains deteriorated in the building industry. The composite indicator has decreased by one point and has reached its lowest level (89) since 1997. It stays below its long-term average. The turning-point indicator is in the unfavorable zone.


Activity remains deteriorated

Substantially more business managers than in July indicate a fall in their past and expected activity. The corresponding balances of opinion are significantly below their long-term average.


Decreasing employment

More business managers than in July indicate job losses for the next few months. The balances of opinion corresponding to past and expected employment remain substantially below their long-term average.

Order books are still considered lower than normal

In August, business managers still consider their order books lower than normal.

Productive capacity underused again

The productive capacity utilization rate is almost stable and stays below its long-term average. At the same time, almost one business manager out of five declares having difficulties increasing his activity.


Prices not very dynamic

In August, almost as many business managers as in July indicate price downturns. The corresponding balance of opinion is well below its long-term average.

Productive capacity utilization rate




Activity tendency in the building industry
