## ■ Enterprise creation - June 2015

### Rebound in business start-ups in June 2015

In June 2015, after having diminished for two months in a row, the number of business births rose again (+3.2% for all enterprises, seasonally and working-day adjusted). This rise was due to a rebound in self-managed micro-entrepreneurs' registrations. Excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs, the increase in number of business start-ups was more moderated (+1.9%).

#### -4.5% year-on-year (quarterly basis)

The raw amount of births added up in the last quarter went down compared to the same quarter one year before (-4.5% for all enterprises and -22.1% for self-managed micro-entrepreneurs alone). The sectors that most contributed<sup>1</sup> to that decrease were construction and retail.

#### -0.9% year-on-year (twelve months basis)

During the last twelve months, the raw number of business start-ups decreased (-0.9% year-on-year). The drop in sole proprietorships births (-2.7%) was partly balanced by the rise in companies set-ups (+3.1%).

#### Nearly half of business set-ups are self-managed micro-entrepreneurs

In June 2015, 47.6% of business set-ups over the last twelve months were micro-entrepreneurs' registrations.



### Source and definitions

The business start-ups data are build from Sirene register information. The definition of creation adopted by INSEE is based on the concept defined by EUROSTAT, to harmonize and compare European data.

The appearance of a legal operating unit with no predecessor is considered to be a newly created enterprise by Eurostat. This concept of creation relies on new production resources. The business start-up statistics include applications for start-ups as micro-entrepreneurs, starting from the data relating to January 2009.

### Raw data and sa-wda

The raw data are observed data. Raw data for a given month may undergo slight modifications during the processing of the following month(s) but become final on the third issue. To allow monthly comparisons, the number of business start-ups is seasonally (sa) and working-day adjusted (wda) with the X12 procedure from SAS software.

**N.B.:** The series of business start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs and micro-entrepreneurs are adjusted independently of each other, for each sector activity. However, for the self-managed micro-entrepreneurs in the sectors "Financial and insurance activities", "Real estate activities" or "Transportation and storage" raw raw data are similar to seasonally adjusted data, due to a low number of registrations and difficulty identifying a seasonal trend. The serie sa-wda "total" is the total of the series sa-wda by activity sectors on A10.
