**Enterprise creation - January 2016** 

## Rise in business start-ups in January 2016

In January 2016, the number of business births kept growing (+3.1% following +1.4% in December for all entreprises, seasonally and working-day adjusted). This rise was a result of the significant upturn in start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs (+4.8%).

## +0.7% year-on-year (quarterly basis)

The raw amount of births added up in the last three months edged up by 0.7% compared to the same months one year before. Sole proprietorships creations excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs shoot up (+26.4%). Transportation and trade were the sectors that most contributed to the overall rise<sup>1</sup>.

## -3.2% year-on-year (twelve months basis)

The raw number of business start-ups totted up during the last twelve months came down by 3.2% year-on-year. This was the result of the sharp drop of self-managed microentrepreneurs' set-ups (-20.0%). Conversely, sole proprietorships creations excluding self-managed microentrepreneurs soared (+28.6%) and companies' start-ups also improved (+5.4%).

## Two business set-ups out of five are self-managed micro-entrepreneur's registrations

In January 2016, micro-entrepreneurs' registrations amounted to 42.6% of business set-ups over the twelve last months. One year before, the share was 51,0%.



## Source and definitions

The business start-ups data are build from Sirene register information. The definition of creation adopted by INSEE is based on the concept defined by EUROSTAT, to harmonize and compare European data.

The appearance of a legal operating unit with no predecessor is considered to be a newly created enterprise by Eurostat. This concept of creation relies on new production resources. The business start-up statistics include applications for start-ups as micro-entrepreneurs, starting from the data relating to January 2009.

## Raw data and sa-wda

The raw data are observed data. Raw data for a given month may undergo slight modifications during the processing of the following month(s) but become final on the third issue. To allow monthly comparisons, the number of business start-ups is seasonally (sa) and working-day adjusted (wda) with the X12 procedure from SAS software.

**N.B.:** The series of business start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs and micro-entrepreneurs are adjusted independently of each other, for each sector activity. However, for the self-managed micro-entrepreneurs in the sectors "Financial and insurance activities", "Real estate activities" or "Transportation and storage" raw raw data are similar to seasonally adjusted data, due to a low number of registrations and difficulty identifying a seasonal trend. The serie sa-wda "total" is the total of the series sa-wda by activity sectors on A10.
