■ Flash estimate - Job creation in non-farm market sectors - 3rd Quarter 2016

In Q3 2016, payroll employment continued to increase, driven by temporary work (flash estimate)

In Q3 2016, payroll employment continued to increase in the non-farm market sectors (+0.3%). With 52,200 net new jobs, it increased more than in the previous quarter (+29,500 jobs). This acceleration is driven by the temporary employment (+5.1%, that is +29,600 jobs, after 0.0% in Q2 2016). Year-on-year, payroll employment rose by +0.9% (+145,100 jobs).

Employment continued to drop in industry (-0.3%, i.e. -9,100 jobs). In construction, it stabilised (0.0%, i.e. +300 jobs after -0.2% in the previous quarter). Year-on-year, industry shed more jobs (-33,100) than construction (-7,100).

Overall tertiary-sector employment speeded up (+0.5%, that is +60,900 jobs, after +0.4% in Q2 2016). However, in services excluding temporary work, net job creation was a little lower than in the previous quarter (+31,300 jobs, i.e. +0.3% after +0.4% in Q2 2016). Over a year, excluding temporary work, employment in services increased by +1.2% that is 136,300 jobs. All in all, employment in the non-farm market sectors excluding temporary work increased by 0.6% over a year (+96,100 jobs).

Temporary work increased strongly

Temporary work rebounded (+5.1% that is +29,600 jobs), after two quarters of near stability. Year-on-year, it increased sharply (+8.6%, +49,000 jobs).
