In October 2016, business prospects darken in the building crafts sector

Craftsmen's personal business prospects darken again

In October 2016, more building craftsmen than in July forecast a fall in their activity, the balance going back below its long-term average. The balance on past activity is stable at a level close to its long-term average. Likewise, opinion of craftsmen concerning the general business outlook in the building sector is virtually stable; it remains well above its long-term average.

Slight improvement in employment in summer but employment prospects decline slightly

Slightly fewer craftsmen than in July indicate a fall in their staff size during the last months. The corresponding balance of opinion has exceeded its long-term average for the first time since April 2008. On the contrary, slightly more craftsmen than in July forecast a fall in their staff size. The corresponding balance remains close to its long-term average.

Less than one firm out of three has recruiting problems

In October 2016, 29% of businesses have experienced recruiting problems. This proportion has increased slightly compared to the last quarter and stay well below its long-term average (41%). Slightly less businesses indicate that they train apprentices: their share has reached 36%, falling slightly below its long-term average.


