Main indicators

■ Consumer Prices index – April 2017

In April 2017, consumer prices rose by 0.1% over a month and by 1.2% year on year

Monthly change: +0.1%;

Year-on-year change: +1.2%

In April 2017, the Consumer Prices Index (CPI) was at a standstill (+0.1% over a month after +0.6% in March). Seasonally adjusted, it was stable, as in the previous month. Year on year, consumer prices accelerated barely, to +1.2% after +1.1% in the previous month.

Over a month, this marked slowdown came from that, seasonal, of manufactured product prices. Energy and food prices fell again, but less than in the previous month. Contrariwise, services prices accelerated a little, due to a sharp rebound in transport services prices.

Sharp slowdown in the prices of manufactured products

In April 2017, manufactured product prices slackened sharply (+0.1% after +2.5%). Year on year, the fall in prices eased again (-0.7% after -1.0% in March and -1.6% in February). Seasonally in April, clothing and footwear prices slowed down (+0.9% after +14.5%; -0.1% year on year). The prices of "other manufactured products" were stable after an increase of 0.6% in the previous month. This stability resulted from a downturn in the prices of furniture and furnishings (-0.3%), major household appliances (-0.9%) and toys and games (-1.8%), partly offset by a rise in the prices of other goods, particularly new motor cars (+0.3%) and glassware, tableware and household utensils (+0.5%). Year on year, the prices of other manufactured products declined less than in March (-0.3% after -0.7%). The prices of health products fell by 0.3%, as in the previous month (-2.3% year on year).

Moderate drop in energy prices

In April 2017, energy prices dropped again (-0.3% after -0.5%). Over a year, the rise in prices eased a little, albeit remaining strong continued to be dynamic: $+9.3\%$ after $+9.9\%$ in March.

This lesser decline over a month came from a more moderate drop in petroleum product prices than in March (-0.3% after -1.6% ; $+15.0\%$ year on year), in the wake of Brent crude price. Contrariwise, the prices of natural gas and city gas slipped back after a sharp increase in March (-0.7% after $+2.4\%$; $+11.8\%$ year on year). Electricity prices have been unchanged since August 2016 (-0.3% year on year).

Near-stability in food prices

Food prices fell slightly in April 2017 (-0.3% over a month after -0.3%) due to a smaller drop in fresh food prices (-1.2% after -2.4%). Excluding fresh products, food prices hardly increased, as in the previous month ($+0.1\%$). Year on year, food prices accelerated a little ($+0.7\%$ after $+0.8\%$).


A little more marked rise in services prices

In April 2017, the prices of services accelerated slightly over a month, to $+0.2\%$ after $+0.1\%$ in the previous month. Year on year, they slowed a little ($+1.0\%$ after $+1.1\%$ in March). The slight monthly rise reflected a rebound in some touristic services prices due to the spring holidays, as airfares ($+11.1\%$ after -0.9% ; $+8.7\%$ over a year) and package holiday prices ($+5.3\%$; -0.4% year on year). The prices of recreational and cultural services went up ($+0.4\%$; $+1.3\%$ year on year), because of an increase in prices of cinema tickets and entrances to amusement parks. On the other hand, the prices of accommodation services fell back (-4.9% ; $+1.3\%$ year on year). Similarly, insurance prices edged down (-0.1% ; $+1.4\%$ year on year), due to a downturn in transport insurance partly offset by a rise in dwelling insurance. The prices of health services were stable after a slight rise in the previous month by $+0.1\%$ ($+0.3\%$ year on year).

Slight increase in year-on-year core inflation

In April 2017, the core inflation indicator (ISJ) rose at the same pace as in the previous month ($+0.2\%$). Year on year, it slightly accelerated ($+0.5\%$ after $+0.4\%$). The Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices (HICP) slowed down sharply ($+0.1\%$ after $+0.7\%$ over a month); over a year, it grew by 1.4% , as in the two previous months.
