Rebound in business start-ups in May 2017

In May 2017, the number of business births for all enterprises rebounded (+1.6% after -1.9% in April, seasonally and working-day adjusted). Micro-entrepreneurs' registrations picked up (+1.7% after -2.9%) as well as start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs (+1.6% after -1.2%).

+0.7% year on year (three months basis)

Compared to the same period one year before, the raw amount of births added up in the last three months slightly increased in May (+0.7% in raw data). Company births kept increasing (+4.7%) as well as sole proprietorship start-ups excluding micro-entrepreneurs (+3.2%). On the other hand, micro-entrepreneurs' registrations shrank once more (-4.2%). Business support activities and transportation were the sectors that contributed the most to the overall rise¹.

+2.9% over the last twelve months

The raw number of business start-ups totted up during the last twelve months kept growing (+2.9% year on year after +4.6% in April). This rise was mostly due to sole proprietorship start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs (+6.0%) and company births (+5.6%). As for micro-entrepreneurs' registrations, they fell back (-1.1% after +0.7%).

A little less than two business set-ups out of five are self-managed micro-entrepreneurs' registrations

In May 2017, the share of micro-entrepreneurs' registrations in the businesses set up over the last twelve months amounted to 39.7%. One year before, it was 41.3%.



Revisions

The variation in the overall number of business births in April 2017 has been lowered by 0.2 points to -1.9% due to the revision of raw data and the update of the SA-WDA parameters.


**Trade and business support activities start-ups

Source and definitions

The business start-ups data are build from Sirene register information. The definition of creation adopted by INSEE is based on the concept defined by EUROSTAT, to harmonize and compare European data.

The appearance of a legal operating unit with no predecessor is considered to be a newly created enterprise by Eurostat. This concept of creation relies on new production resources. The business start-up statistics include applications for start-ups as micro-entrepreneurs, starting from the data relating to January 2009.

Raw data and sa-wda

The raw data are observed data. Raw data for a given month may undergo slight modifications during the processing of the following month(s) but become final on the third issue. To allow monthly comparisons, the number of business start-ups is seasonally (SA) and working-day adjusted (WDA) with the X-12-ARIMA procedure from JDemetra+ software.

N.B.: The series of business start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs and micro-entrepreneurs are adjusted independently of each other, for each sector activity. The serie SA-WDA "total" is the total of the series SA-WDA by activity sectors on A10 or A21 of the Naf rév.2, 2008.
