■ Prices index – provisional results June 2017

In June 2017, consumer prices increased by 0.7% year on year

Over a year, the Consumer Price Index (CPI) should decelerate slightly in June 2017 (+0.7% after +0.8% in May), according to the provisional estimate made at the end of the month. This slight decrease in year-on-year inflation should be due to a further slowdown in energy prices. Services prices are set to rise at the same pace as in May. On the other hand, food prices should accelerate and manufactured product prices should decline less strongly than in the previous month.

Over one month, consumer prices should be stable, as in May. This stability should come from a fall in energy prices and a seasonal downturn in food prices, offset by a rise in services prices due to a rebound in transport services. Manufactured product prices should grow barely, as in the two previous months.

Year on year, the Harmonised Index of Consumer Prices should slow down hardly, to +0.8% after +0.9% in the previous month. Over one month, it should be stable, as in May.

Warning: These provisional results are only preliminary data. Accordingly, they should not be used for contractual revaluations. The indices published here are based on a limited set of price observations and from estimates of some rates of change for fares which are not yet available. The complete results will be published on 13 July 2017.

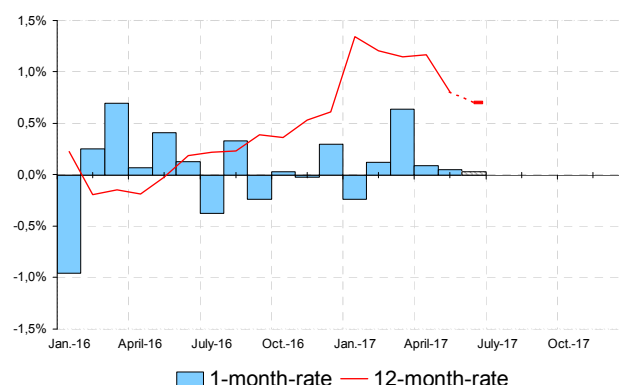
