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■ Prices index in large and predominantly food stores – June 2017

In June 2017, the prices of frequently purchased goods rose by 0.1% in hyper and supermarkets

In June 2017, the prices of frequently purchased goods in hyper and supermarkets and in large and predominantly food stores slowed down slightly: +0.1% over a month after +0.2% in the previous month.

Similarly, excluding hyper and supermarkets, prices rose more slowly than in May (+0.1% after +0.2%).

Considering all the kinds of stores, the prices of frequently purchased goods increased at a slower pace than in May (+0.1% after +0.2%).

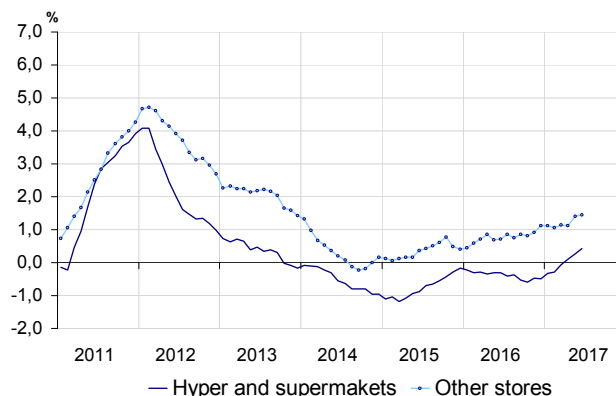
Year on year, the prices in hyper and supermarkets continue to rise

Compared with the same month last year, the prices of frequently purchased goods sold in hyper and supermarkets continued to accelerate (+0.4% after +0.1% in April and +0.3% in May). In the same way, prices in large and predominantly food stores accelerated (+0.4% after +0.3% in May).

In the other kinds of stores, the prices of frequently purchased goods grew at a slightly higher pace than in the previous month: +1.5% over a year after +1.4% in the previous month.

Considering all stores, the prices of frequently purchased goods rose slightly more significantly than in the previous month: +0.5% year on year after +0.4%.

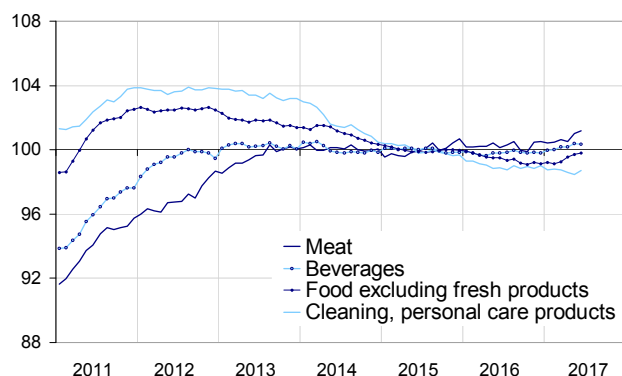

Low increase in food prices in hyper and supermarkets

In June 2017, the prices of food excluding fresh products sold in hyper and supermarkets increased less than in the previous month (+0.1% after +0.3%). Year on year, their rise was slightly higher (+0.5% after +0.4% in May).

The slight slowdown in prices over a month resulted from a lesser increase in prices for meat and other food products. Prices for beverages remained stable.

Meat prices decelerated in June after a rebound in the previous month (+0.2% after +0.5%). However, year on year, they accelerated for the second month in a row: +1.1% after +0.6% in May.

Prices of beverages sold in hyper and supermarkets were stable anew, after a rise of 0.2% in May. Year on year, prices were slightly less dynamic than in the previous month (+0.5% after +0.6%).

The prices of other food products (excluding fresh food) slowed down slightly (+0.1% after +0.2%). Year on year, they accelerated slightly (+0.3% after +0.2%).

Rebound in the prices of cleaning and personal care products in hyper and supermarkets

The prices of cleaning and personal care products sold in hyper and supermarkets recovered in June (+0.3%) after a drop of 0.2% in April and in May. Year on year, the price decline for these products was less pronounced than in the previous month (-0.2% after -0.4%).
