■ Prices index in large and predominantly food stores – July 2017

In July 2017, the prices of frequently purchased goods rose by 0.1% in hyper and supermarkets

In July 2017, the prices of frequently purchased goods in hyper and supermarkets and in large and predominantly food stores increased slightly: +0.1% over a month as in the previous month.

Excluding hyper and supermarkets, prices rose a little faster than in June (+0.2% after +0.1%).

Considering all the kinds of stores, the prices of frequently purchased goods increased slightly, as in June (+0.1%).


Year on year, prices accelerated in hyper and supermarkets

Compared with the same month last year, the prices of frequently purchased goods sold in hyper and supermarkets have been accelerating gradually (+0.6% in July after +0.4% in June, +0.3% in May and +0.1% in April). The same is true in large and predominantly food stores (+0.6% after +0.4% in June and +0.3% in May).

In the other kinds of stores, the prices of frequently purchased goods have continued to increase more markedly than for large distributors: in July they rose by +1.5% year on year, as in the previous month.

Considering all stores, the prices of frequently purchased goods rose slightly more significantly than in the previous month: +0.6% year on year after +0.5%.



Slight increase in food prices in hyper and supermarkets

In July 2017, the prices of food excluding fresh products sold in hyper and supermarkets were up slightly, a little more than in the previous month (+0.2% after +0.1%). Year on year, their rise was sharper (+0.7% after +0.5% in June).

The slight acceleration in prices over a month resulted from a slightly larger increase in prices for beverages and other food products, whereas the prices for meat slowed down a little.

In July, meat prices decelerated again (+0.1% after +0.2% in June and +0.5% in May). Year on year, they slowed down after a clear acceleration in the previous month (+1.0% after +1.1% in June).

The prices of beverages sold in hyper and supermarkets rose slightly (+0.1%), after a stability in June. Year on year, these prices were slightly more dynamic than in the previous month (+0.6% after +0.5%).

The prices of other food products (excluding fresh food) speeded up a little (+0.2% after +0.1%). Year on year, they gathered pace (+0.7% after +0.3%).

Modest rise in the prices of cleaning and personal care products in hyper and supermarkets

The prices of cleaning and personal care products sold in hyper and supermarkets grew more slightly in July (+0.1%) than in June (+0.3%). Year on year, the prices of these products were stable whereas they had been diminishing since June 2013.
