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■ Turnover in industry and construction – July 2017

In July 2017, the turnover in the manufacturing industry recovered (+0.7%)

The commentary shows variations of subsections by decreasing contribution to the overall evolution. The contribution of a subsection depends on the extent of the change and on its weight.

In July 2017, the turnover recovered in the manufacturing industry (+0.7% after -2.5% in June) as well as in industry as a whole (+0.6% in July after -1.9%). It recovered in export sales as well.

Rise over the last three months (+1.1%)


Over the last three months, the turnover rose in the manufacturing industry (+1.1%) as well as in the industry as a whole (+0.7%). In the manufacturing industry, the turnover grew sharply in "other manufacturing" (+1.9%) and, in the manufacture of transport equipment (+2.5%). It rose to a lesser extent in the manufacture of food products and beverages (+0.9%) and in the machinery and equipment goods (+0.2%). Conversely, it declined strongly in the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (-8.5%).

Strong increase compared to the previous year (+7.4%)

In the manufacturing industry, the turnover grew strongly from the same three months of the previous year (+7.4%). This increase was even more marked in industry as a whole (+8.3%) due to mining and quarrying, energy, water supply, waste management (+12.1%). Over this period, the turnover rose strongly in every main sectors of the manufacturing industry – "other manufacturing" (+7.5%), the manufacture of transport equipment (+9.6%), the manufacture of food products and beverages (+5.0%), the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (+16.8%) and the machinery and equipment sector (+5.0%).

How to read it: in the manufacturing, the SA-WDA variation between May and June 2017 is revised by 0.01 points: +0.09 points are due to the raw series' revision and -0.08 to the new calculation of the SA-WDA.

Sharp rebound in transport equipment (+6.1%)

The turnover in the manufacture of transport equipment recovered sharply in July (+6.1% after -8.2% in June). It rebounded strongly in the manufacture of other transport equipment (+9.6% after -12.4%). It recovered also in the manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (+2.2% after -3.1%). The rebound was also marked in export sales (+4.1% after -3.1%).

Decrease in coke and refined petroleum products (-2.7%)

In July, the turnover fell in the manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (-2.7%) after a virtual stability in June (-0.1%).

Further decrease in "other manufacturing" (-0.6%)

The turnover in "other manufacturing" fell again in July (-0.6% after -0.9%). It declined very sharply in the manufacture of basic pharmaceutical products and pharmaceutical preparations (-3.5%) It also fell in other manufacturing (-1.5%), in the manufacture of rubber and plastic products (-1.0%), in the manufacture of basic metals and fabricated metal products, except machinery and equipment (-0.5%) and in the manufacture of wood and paper products (-1.3%). Conversely, the turnover rose again in the manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (+2.4%). It was unchanged in the manufacture of textiles, wearing apparel, leather and related products. In export sales as well, the turnover slipped back in "other manufacturing" (-1.2% after +0.4%).

Virtual stability in food products and beverages (+0.1%)

The turnover in the manufacture of food products and beverages was virtually stable in July (+0.1% after -1.9%) and fell sharply again in export sales (-1.6% after -3.1%).

Stability in machinery and equipment

The turnover in machinery and equipment was stable in July after a downturn in June (-1.6%). It rebounded in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (+2.9% after -2.1%) but it slipped back in the manufacture of electrical equipment (-3.6% after +0.3%). It was stable for manufacture of machinery and equipment. The export sales in machinery and equipment rebounded in July (+1.5% after -1.3%).

Revisions

The variation in the turnover index in June 2017 is unchanged compared to the previous publication, both in the manufacturing industry and in industry as a whole. The adjustment of SA-WDA parameters offsets the raw series' variation.
