■ Enterprise births - October 2017

Rise in business start-ups in October 2017

In October 2017, the number of business births for all enterprises rose (+2.6%, seasonally and working-day adjusted), following a near-stability in September. Start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs speeded up (+4.2% after +0.6%) and micro-entrepreneurs' registrations slightly rebounded (+0.3% after -0.3%).

+10.6% year on year (three months basis)

Compared to the same period one year before, the raw amount of births added up in the last three months went up strongly (+10.6% in raw data). Micro-entrepreneurs' registrations increased sharply (+13.8%) as well as sole proprietorship start-ups excluding micro-entrepreneurs (+9.9%). It was also the case for company births but at a slower pace (+6.8%). Business support activities and trade were the sectors that contributed the most to the overall rise¹.

+5.3% over the last twelve months

The raw number of business start-ups totted up during the last twelve months kept growing (+5.3% after +3.2%). All the types of business start-ups expanded : company births by +5.8%, micro-entrepreneurs' registrations by +5.2% and sole proprietorship start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs by +4.8%.

Two business set-ups out of five are self-managed micro-entrepreneurs' registrations

In October 2017, the share of micro-entrepreneurs' registrations in the businesses set up over the last twelve months was steady at 40.3%.




• Business set-ups by economic activity

Source and definitions

The business start-ups data are build from Sirene register information. The definition of creation adopted by INSEE is based on the concept defined by EUROSTAT, to harmonize and compare European data.

The appearance of a legal operating unit with no predecessor is considered to be a newly created enterprise by Eurostat. This concept of creation relies on new production resources. The business start-up statistics include applications for start-ups as micro-entrepreneurs, starting from the data relating to January 2009.

Raw data and sa-wda

The raw data are observed data. Raw data for a given month may undergo slight modifications during the processing of the following month(s) but become final on the third issue. To allow monthly comparisons, the number of business start-ups is seasonally (SA) and working-day adjusted (WDA) with the X-12-ARIMA procedure from JDemetra+ software.

N. B.: the series of business start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs and micro-entrepreneurs are adjusted independently of each other, for each sector activity. The serie SA-WDA "total" is the total of the series SA-WDA by activity sectors on A10 or A21 of the Naf rév.2, 2008.
