## Main indicators

### ■ Enterprise births - January 2018

#### Rebound in business start-ups in January 2018

In January 2018, the number of business births for all enterprises fell back (+3.6% after -1.5% in December, seasonally and working-day adjusted). This was due to the sharp growth in micro-entrepreneurs' registrations (+9.1% after -6.5%). On the other hand, conventional businesses fell back slightly (-0.3% after +2.3%).

#### +7.7% over the twelve last months

The raw number of business start-ups totted up during the last twelve months kept accelerating (+7.7% after +6.7% in December and +6.1% in November). All the types of business start-ups increased: micro-entrepreneurs' registrations (+10.5%), conventional sole proprietorship start-ups (+8.1%) and company births (+4.1%).

#### Upsurge of business set-ups in business support activities over the twelve last months

In raw data over the twelve last months, business support activities was the sector that contributed the most to the overall rise (+16,600 business start-ups, which comes to a contribution of 3 points to the total)<sup>1</sup>. Within it, the increase was the higher in business and management counselling (+10,700 over the twelve last months).

#### Two business set-ups out of five are self-managed micro-entrepreneurs' registrations

In January 2018, the share of micro-entrepreneurs' registrations in the businesses set up over the last twelve months increased for the third month in a row and reached 41.3%.





The variation in the overall number of business births in November 2017 has been raised by 0.4 points to -1.5% due to the revision of raw data and the update of the SA-WDA parameters.



## For more information

### Source and definitions

The business start-ups data are build from the Register of Enterprises and Establishments (REE), from Sirene register information. The definition of creation adopted by INSEE is based on the concept defined by Eurostat, to harmonize and compare European data.

The appearance of a legal operating unit with no predecessor is considered to be a newly created enterprise by Eurostat. This concept of creation relies on new production resources. The business start-up statistics include applications for start-ups as micro-entrepreneurs, starting from the data relating to January 2009. Since this date, sole proprietorships excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs are called **conventional sole proprietorships** and start-ups excluding self-managed micro-entrepreneurs are called **conventional businesses**.
