Housing Rent Reference Index – First quarter 2018

In Q1 2018, the Housing Rent Reference Index increased by 1.05% over a year

In Q1 2018, the Housing Rent Reference Index stood at 127.22. Year on year, it increased by 1.05%, as in the previous quarter.



Warning

The consumer price index (CPI) has changed reference year in January 2016. The new series of the CPI has been used to calculate the Housing Rent Reference Index (HRR) since the first quarter of 2016. The Housing Rent Reference Index reference period is not modified, however. This change in the calculation method of the CPI has no impact for users of the HRR.

Methodology

The Law of February 8th, 2008 n° 2008-111 on purchasing power modified the Housing Rent Reference Index created (IRL) by the Law of July 26th, 2005 n° 2005-841. It is an over-the-year chain-linked index. It is constructed by multiplying the index of same quarter of previous year by the change between these two periods in the average over twelve consecutive months of consumer price index excluding tobacco and rents.

This index is referenced 100 on the Q4 1998.

The calculation is done using the non-rounded up values of the consumer price index without tobacco and rent.

The housing rent reference index and the annual variation of the housing rent reference index are rounded up to two decimals.
