Enterprise births - December 2018

Slight rise in business start-ups in December 2018

In December 2018, the number of business births for all enterprises increased slightly ($\pm 0.3\%$ after $\pm 5.6\%$ in November, seasonally and working-day adjusted). Conventional businesses start-ups dropped ($\pm 1.1\%$ after $\pm 0.3\%$) while microentrepreneurs' registrations rebounded ($\pm 2.1\%$ after $\pm 1.4\%$).



+16.9% over the twelve last months

The raw number of business start-ups totted up during the last twelve months slowed down slightly (+16.9% after +17.3% in November and +18.5% in October). All the types of business start-ups increased: micro-entrepreneurs' registrations (+27.5%), conventional sole proprietorship start-ups (+20.0%) and, to a lesser extent, company births (+1.6%).

Upsurge of business setp-ups in transportation and storage over the three last months

The raw number of business start-ups totted up during the last three months went up sharply (+13.5% over one year). The sector "Transportation and storage" was the one that contributed the most to this rise (rise by +8,000 business start-ups, which comes to a contribution of 6.0 points)¹. Over the last three months and compared to the same months a year earlier, the number of creators grew by 8,000 in this sector (of which +7,200 in other postal and mail activities including home delivery).

1, The contribution of a sector to the overall variation is the variation observed in this sector, weighted by the share of this sector in the total number of births.

More than two business set-ups out of five are self-managed micro-entrepreneurs' registrations

In December 2018, the share of micro-entrepreneurs' registrations in the businesses set up over the last twelve months grew for the fourteenth month in a row and reached 44.6%.



Revisions

The variation in the overall number of business births in November 2018 has been lowered by 0.3 points to -5.6% due to the revision of raw data and the update of the SA-WDA parameters.

Construction and transportation business set-ups (SA-WDA*)




Figure7 Number of monthly business set-ups (incl. self-managed micro-entrepreneurs)
